She lost her father when she was in 4th standard, and her mother works as a construction labourer to provide for the family. However, it was impossible for her to pay college fees.

Mohammed Faiz is in the 3rd year of MBBS at Kanachur Institute of Medical Sciences, Mangalore. It has been his dream to become a doctor and serve humanity.

His father, a Hafeez e Quran, runs a small chicken shop and with his limited income manages to cover their household needs. However, it was becoming difficult to pay Faiz's 3rd year fees.

Alhamdulillah, IndiaZakat helped him raise **Rs. 2 lakhs**, so that he could continue with his MBBS.




MUBASHIRA TASNEEM CHIYA

of the Ambur Chapter's activities.






