Empowering Through Education | Inspiring Through Action AMP 25-Year Roadmap Consultation Held in Hyderabad

A landmark consultative meeting on AMP's 25-Year Roadmap for Educational and Economic Development of Indian Muslims was held on Sunday, 14th September 2025, at Madina Education Centre, Hyderabad.

फेरोजपुर झिरका उपमंडल के दोहा गांव मोड पर स्थित की तिक्षा भी उन्हें मिल सके।रविवार को मेवात के रखते हैं। उन्होंने हाल ही में बच्चियों के लिए कंप्यूटर सिस्टम की राह तैयार कर रहे हैं। वस्था करने का आश्वासन दिया, ताकि आधुनिक तकनीक

पतिमा तुत्र जोहरा मदरसा वर्ष 2015 से बेटियों की तालीम किफायत उल्लाह बचोला और जाकिर हुसैन नसीरकाल ने के लिए एक मिसाल बनकर सामने आया है। ट्रस्ट एक्ट में गदरनो का दौरा किया। उन्होंने बच्चियों के खान-पान, रहन रजिस्टर्ड यह मदरसा इस समय 150 बच्चियों को हिंदी, इंग्लिश सहन और साफ-सफाई की व्यवस्था कर निरीक्षण किया और उर्दू साहित अन्य विषयों की शिक्षा दे रहा है। खास बात यह जाकिन हुसैन ने बताया कि मदरसे का प्रबंधन बेहद बेहतर है कि यहां बच्चियों से कोई सुख्य नहीं तिया जाता, बल्कि मिला और विकिट के दौरान बच्चियों को व्यवस्थित तरीके से उनके तिए खाने-पीने, रहने-सहने और पढ़ाई की सभी सुविधाएं खाना प्रतेसा जा रहा था। उन्होंने डायरेक्टर नदीम को क्याई मुफ्त मुहैया कराई जाती हैं। बब्धियों को पढ़ाने के लिए महिला दी। यहीं, समाजसंबी किपवयत उल्लाह बच्चोता ने कहा कि शिक्षिकाए नियुक्त हैं, जिससे बेटियां सुरक्षित माहौत में शिक्षा प्रधानमंत्री नरेंद्र गोदी ने मुसलमानों के एक हाथ में कुरान और हासिल कर रही हैं। मदरमें के संचालन की जिम्मेदारी डायरेक्टर - दूसरे हाथ में कंप्यूटर की बात कही थी। उसी सोच के तहत भाई नदीम के कर्यों पर है, जो दिन-रात मेहनत कर बच्चियों को आज मदरसों में दीनी तालीम के साथ-साथ दुनियावी तालीम ताचुनिक और दीनी तालीम दिलाने में जुटे हुए हैं। गांव के लोग. भी दी जा रही है, जिससे बच्चिया बेहतर और सलीकेदार इस नेक कार्य में हर संभव सहयोग दे रहे हैं। समय-समय जिंदगी जी सकें। फातिमा तुज जोहरा मदरसा आज क्षेत्र में पर दोहा गांव के सरपंच आजाद मोहम्मद भी मदरसे पहुंचकर बेटियों की तालीम और तरक्की का प्रतीक बन चुका है, जहां बच्चियों का हीसला बढ़ाते रहे हैं और उनकी जरूरतों का ध्यान. समाज और प्रशासन मिलकर बच्चियों के सुनहरे भविष्य की

IndiaZakat cause id no: 21998 - Rukhsar works as a delivery agent to support her family and take care of her parents' daily expenses. She used to borrow someone's bike to do her delivery job, however, that bike was no longer available, and she was unable to continue her work. Through someone's help she raised a cause on IndiaZakat for a second-hand Activa scooter. Alhamdulillah, Rs. 30,000 was raised and she could continue her livelihood.





IndiaZakat cause id no: 21091 - Munna Khan lives in Tonk, Rajasthan and his family consists of three daughters who are of marriageable age. The responsibility of providing for them and managing household expenses rests entirely on him. For years, he has worked as a daily wage laborer to make ends meet, but his health is not in good condition. He wanted to start his own tea stall and IndiaZakat helped him raise Rs. 6,000/-so he could earn his livelihood without difficulty, Alhamdulillah!

IndiaZakat cause id no: 22106 - Naazma lives in Rajasthan with her husband and two beloved daughters. Her husband is unwell, suffering from a serious stomach-related illness. His condition has left him unable to work, and I've become the sole caretaker of our family. Despite the pain and hardship, she wanted to start a small home-based grocery store, so she could earn a halal income with dignity and provide for her family. Alhamdulillah, IndiaZakat helped her raise a cause and the required funds needed of Rs. 32,000/- for the same.



She is eternally grateful to the volunteers and IndiaZakat for the help.

AMP EAC is one of the core projects of AMP and was formed in 2015. It was launched keeping in mind AMP's objective of supporting the underprivileged, through economic empowerment, by providing career opportunities to the unemployed youth.

Through our EAC, we organise Job Drives, Job Fairs, Employability & Skill Training Programs, to make the youth employable, to provide them of career opportunities, and to economically and socially empower them.













School Development Programs (SDP)

SDP is one of AMP's earliest and a flagship initiative, which has proven to be highly impactful. The SDP's encompass three key components:

- 1. Skills Development Lectures (SDLs): DLs offer comprehensive guidance to High-School students on career planning and self-development.
- 2. **Teacher Training Workshops (TTWs):** TTWs are designed to continually enhance the knowledge and skills of teachers, who are vital to the success of any educational institution.
- 3. Parenting Workshops (Pws): PWs engage parents in understanding recent advancements in educational practices, equipping them to better support their children's learning.


