1st October 2025: Shape Your Child's Future at an Inspiring Career Guidance Seminar



Speakers: Maulana Khalid Rasheed Farangi Mahli, Mr. Aamir Edresy, and Dr. Abdul Ahad.




22nd October 2025: AMP Kolkata Hosts Mega Meet featuring

Headmaster Dr. Shahul Hameed and students participated enthusiastically.






31st October,2025: Felicitation programme of a special Teacher

With the kind help of some generous donors, they managed her 1st year fee but it



was getting difficult for the 2nd year. Alhamdulillah, the Cause on IndiaZakat helped her arrange part of the fees.



IndiaZakat cause id no: 23522 - Mohammad Ameen is a 2nd-year B.Tech (Computer Science) student from Kota, Rajasthan.

His father works in a private electronic showroom, but his income is not sufficient to support the family, including his mother, who is a housewife, and a younger sibling who is studying in 9th grade.

Ameen does a part-time job, but despite

working hard alongside his studies, they were unable to fully cover his college fees. He raised a Cause on IndiaZakat, which helped him to pay his fees, Alhamdulillah!

IndiaZakat cause id no: 23594 Thaslima is a second-year B.Com student at Wavoo Wajeeha Women's College of Arts and Science, Kayalpatnam. She lost her father last year, and since then, her family has been facing immense financial struggles.

They have to manage their daily life without any income and thus paying her college fees had become nearly impossible.



Alhamdulillah, through her cause on IndiaZakat, she was able to raise the required fees.
