


It is AMP's Zakat based 'Crowd-Funding' platform, which in simple terms connects the Donor and Seeker, so that the 'Need' of both is fulfilled as required by the 'Shariah'.

IndiaZakat.com is powered by an Advisory Board of national & international Ulemas and a Zakat Council, a team of highly qualified and senior professionals, with the upliftment of the Community at the core of their heart.

Over the past 5 years, the impact of IndiaZakat has been truly transformative;

In the month of December 2025, 161 Causes were funded by 887 Donors.

IndiaZakat Beneficiaries

IndiaZakatCause ID – 22849

Tahoora Maheen is an orphan student pursuing her 2nd year Diploma in Medical Laboratory Technology at Noble College, Kalaburagi. She dreamt of becoming a Lab Technician and serving humanity through healthcare.

However, after her father's tragic demise, her widowed mother was unable to afford her education. Without support, Tahoora's studies were at risk.

She raised a Cause on IndiaZakat, and Alhamdulillah managed to raise Rs. 34,000/- for her fees.



IndiaZakat Cause ID – 24187

Khatri Abdul Khadir is a 1st-year BHMS student at Parul University from a financially struggling family. His father runs a small crockery shop and is the sole earning member supporting a family of five. He was facing a shortfall ₹85,500 in his fees, and the family was unable to arrange this amount.

He had already lost one academic year due to lack of funds. Fortunately, someone recommended IndiaZakat to him and he managed to raise the funds and pay the fees.



IndiaZakat Cause ID – 24065

Mohammed Mustakeem is a sincere and hardworking Class 10 student at Hyder Garden Matriculation School, Perambur, Chennai. His father is a self-employed street cart vendor with a limited income, struggling to meet the family's daily needs. With his elder brother pursuing BCA, the family faced significant difficulty in managing educational expenses.

He managed to raise a cause on IndiaZakat, and Alhamdulillah, an amount of ₹16,810 was successfully raised towards his educational fees.

Employment Assistance Cell (EAC)

AMP EAC is one of the core projects of AMP and was formed in 2015. It was launched keeping in mind AMP's objective of supporting the underprivileged, through economic empowerment, by providing career opportunities to the unemployed youth.

Through our EAC, we organise Job Drives, Job Fairs, Employability & Skill Training Programs, to make the youth employable, to provide them of career opportunities, and to economically and socially empower them.



School Development Programs (SDP)

SDP is one of AMP's earliest and a flagship initiative, which has proven to be highly impactful. The SDP's encompass three key components.

1. Skills Development Lectures (SDLs): SDLs offer comprehensive guidance to High-School students on careerplanning and self-development.
2. Teacher Training Workshops (TTWs): TTWs are designed to continually enhance the knowledge and skills of teachers, who are vital to the success of any educational institution.
3. Parenting Workshops(PWs): PWs engage parents in understanding recent advancements in educational practices, equipping them to better support their children's learning.


