It is AMP's Zakat based 'Crowd-Funding' platform, which in simple terms connects the Donor and Seeker, so that the 'Need' of both is fulfilled as required by the 'Shariah'.


IndiaZakat.com is powered by an Advisory Board of national & international Ulemas and a Zakat Council, a team of highly qualified and senior professionals, with the upliftment of the Community at the core of their heart.

Over the past 5 years, the impact of IndiaZakat has been truly transformative; In the month of January 2026, 208 Causes were funded by 1119 Donors.

#### Cause ID: 23866 | Bangalore, Karnataka

Mr. Shameel from Bangalore works as a taxi driver and is the sole earning member of his family. His wife Shabana Banu is battling breast cancer and has already undergone a mastectomy. With a limited income, the family was finding it extremely difficult to manage the high cost of her ongoing medical treatment, estimated at ₹1,50,000.

Alhamdulillah, with the generous support of donors, ₹32,500 has been raised so far, providing much-needed relief during this critical phase. Continued support will help ensure timely treatment and give Shabana Banu hope for recovery and healing.



### AMP PROJECTS & ACTIVITIES - JANUARY 2026

#### Cause ID: 24024 | Aligarh, Uttar Pradesh

Abdul Kabir Hasan is a Grade 12 student at Krishna Public School, Aligarh, belonging to a family facing severe financial and medical hardship. His father suffered two major heart attacks, leaving him partially paralyzed and unable to work. His mother supports the family through a small home-based honey-selling business, but the income is barely sufficient to meet basic needs.

For the academic year 2025–26, Abdul Kabir required ₹26,600 towards his College fees, which the family was unable to arrange. Thanks to the Support from IndiaZakat donors, Abdul Kabir managed to raise the fees, Alhamdulillah!



#### Cause ID: 23448 | Mumbai, Maharashtra

Ashapak Shaikh is a divorced woman from Mumbai, who faced severe financial hardship while managing daily expenses without a stable source of income. Determined to regain dignity and self-reliance, Najma raised a cause on IndiaZakat to start a small home-based cloth business that would help her earn a respectable livelihood and support her family.

Alhamdulillah, with the generous support of donors, ₹33,400 was successfully raised. This support has brought her closer to setting up her small venture and beginning a journey towards financial independence.



### Employment Assistance Cell (EAC):

AMP EAC is one of the core projects of AMP and was formed in 2015. It was launched keeping in mind AMP's objective of supporting the underprivileged, through economic empowerment, by providing career opportunities to the unemployed youth.

Through our EAC, we organise Job Drives, Job Fairs, Employability & Skill Training Programs, to make the youth employable, to provide them of career opportunities, and to economically and socially empower them.
