
This month reflects not just activities — but systems working at scale.

# International Zakat Conference 2026

14–15 February 2026 | AMU, Aligarh

Maulana Mohammad Fazlur Rahim Mujaddidi, General Secretary of the All India Muslim Personal Law Board and Chief Guest, emphasised that the true objective of Zakat is to establish justice and stability in society. He said, **“The need of the hour is collective and organised Zakat management. When administered systematically, Zakat can bring meaningful change and strengthen the community.”**

Maulana Khalid Rasheed Farangimahali, Chairman of India Islamic Centre, Lucknow, stressed the importance of institutional Zakat. He said, **“Individual Zakat has its rewards, but collective Zakat has its impact. If we seek systemic change, we must move towards organised and accountable Zakat systems.”**

Aamir Edresy, President of the Association of Muslim Professionals (AMP), reiterated AMP’s vision. He said, **“Zakat is not merely a ritual obligation; it is a divine economic system. Our goal is to build a transparent, scalable and technology-driven Zakat ecosystem that empowers families with dignity.”**

Mr. Zahid Mateen, Co-Founder of GlobalSadaqah, Malaysia, highlighted the role of technology in strengthening Zakat systems. He noted, **“With transparency, governance and public dashboards, trust increases — and when trust increases, participation multiplies.”**

Dr. Adnan Salaudeen, Islamic Finance Lecturer and Zakat researcher from Bolton, UK, emphasised the need for structured Zakat frameworks. He remarked, **“For Zakat to be transformative, governance, compliance and measurable outcomes are essential.”**





## Employment Assistance Cell (EAC):

AMP EAC is one of the **core projects** of AMP and was formed in 2015. It was launched keeping in mind AMP's **objective** of supporting the **underprivileged**, through **economic empowerment**, by providing career opportunities to the unemployed youth.

Through our EAC, we organise **Job Drives, Job Fairs, Employability & Skill Training Programs**, to make the youth employable, to provide them of career opportunities, and to economically and socially empower them.

**Cause ID: 24279 | Solapur, Maharashtra**

Daud Gaus Inamdar is a first-year B.Tech student in Electronics & Telecommunication from Solapur. He comes from a humble family where his father, a driver, is the sole earning member with an annual income of around ₹50,000.

With determination to build a better future, Daud secured admission in engineering. The total annual fee is ₹66,677, out of which ₹21,000 has been paid with great difficulty. Arranging the remaining amount is extremely challenging, and without timely payment, he may not be allowed to appear for his semester examinations.

Your Zakat or contribution can help him continue his education and protect his academic year, bringing hope and stability to his family's future.

Mr. Mohammed Hussain earns a meagre income by cleaning fish outside a local market, receiving only ₹20 per kg. As the sole earning member, he struggles to support his wife and two young children in a rented house. Due to financial hardship and recent medical expenses, he has fallen into debt and is unable to send his children to school.

Alhamdulillah, with the generous support of donors, ₹50,800 has been raised so far, providing much-needed relief during this difficult time. Continued support will help him set up a small fish cart, secure a stable livelihood, clear his debts, and ensure a better future for his children.

Mrs. Naseema Shaikh, a mother of two, lives in a small shed house and works as a housemaid, while her husband is a tempo driver. Despite their hard work, their income is barely enough to manage daily expenses.

She had earlier undergone surgery for a hand fracture with a rod implant. Due to financial hardship, proper follow-up treatment was not possible. Now, her hand is severely swollen and infected, and doctors have advised urgent surgery to remove the rod. She is also suffering from diabetes and high blood pressure, which has worsened her condition.

Alhamdulillah, with the generous support of donors, ₹64,950 has been raised so far, bringing much-needed relief. Continued support will help her undergo the urgent surgery and recover, In sha Allah.

## School Development Program (SDP)

The School Development Program (SDP) is one of AMP's earliest and flagship initiatives aimed at strengthening educational institutions through structured interventions. The program focuses on three core areas — Skills Development Lectures (SDLs) for students, Teacher Training Workshops (TTWs) for educators, and Parenting Workshops (PWs) to engage families in the learning process. In February 2026, AMP chapters across multiple states actively implemented SDP-related activities, positively impacting students through career guidance and institutional support.
