Program Overview:

Introduction:

Skill Development Lectures (SDL) caters to students of right from primary till graduation. SDL is accurately planned, content and speaker is strictly selected according to the target audience. For example for primary and secondary students, the topics covered would be, Basics of computer, Motivation, Time management and Career guidance etc. For graduates, topics would be introducing them to the world of business, organization and industries and limited business and economic concepts. These professionals are experienced volunteers from different industries who have extensive knowledge about the industry and understand the qualities needed for succeeding in their area of work.
