AMP intervention through its project is to improve the status of the community with regard to education, employment, employability and helping hand to brothers needing financial support. Scale of our problems is enormous. All available indicators regarding education, poverty, employment put us at bottom among various communities.

Some figures:

Assuming around 20 Crore Muslims in the country.

- 7-8 crores Muslims may be below poverty line (34 percent rural and 36.4 percent urban Muslims are below poverty line {BPL} as on 22nd Oct 2024)
- 5 crore Muslim population may be in age group 0-14 (25.31 percent of the Indian population fell into the 0-14 age group)
- Around 10 crore Muslim population may be below age of 30 (Over half the population {52%} is below 30 yrs of age)

Some Indicators:

- Gross Enrolment ratio of Muslims in higher education – 8.91% against 25.9% of SC and 27% for the country.
- A report says that 18.64% of Muslim students enrolled in the secondary level drop out of schools, which is higher than the 12.6% dropout rate for all students
- We all know the basic mathematical and language skills of primary students, especially in rural areas, is far from satisfactory. Reports like Annual Status on Education is available. Foundational Literacy and Numeracy Skills (FLN): According to the report, in 2023, 73.6 per cent of 14-18-olds could read a grade 2-level text. It is expected that the position for Muslim community would be still worst.
- According to Statista Research Department, in the financial year 2024, the employment rate in India was the highest among Christians, at over 40 percent. The employment rate was the lowest among Muslims during the period.

Above STATISTICS shows the status of the community in education, employment and size of target population of the community on which community leaders is to work. AMP is making effort to address all these issues of the Community. Considering the above glimpse of data, our effort may be drop in ocean but it may lead to awakening in the community and culminate into mass movement to bring about change. If efforts are started now, may be there would be visible impact after a decade.

In my view the Chapter Head is the most important position in AMP. He has to be a leader, the success of AMP programs in the district depends on Chapter Head and CET. You are the face of AMP among local masses and prospective beneficiaries. Wherever we have dynamic Chapter Head there was excellent execution of NTS project.

Need of hour is to work on mission mode. You will make a history for our future generations.

School Development Programs (SDP)

SDP is one of AMP's earliest and a flagship initiative, which has proven to be highly impactful. The SDP's encompass three key components:

Skills Development Lectures (SDLs): SDLs offer comprehensive guidance to High-School students on career planning and self-development.

Teacher Training Workshops (TTWs): TTWs are designed to continually enhance the knowledge and skills of teachers, who are vital to the success of any educational institution.

Parenting Workshops (PWs): PWs engage parents in understanding recent advancements in educational practices, equipping them to better support their children's learning.

In December 2024, following States and their Chapters carried out following SDP Activities.

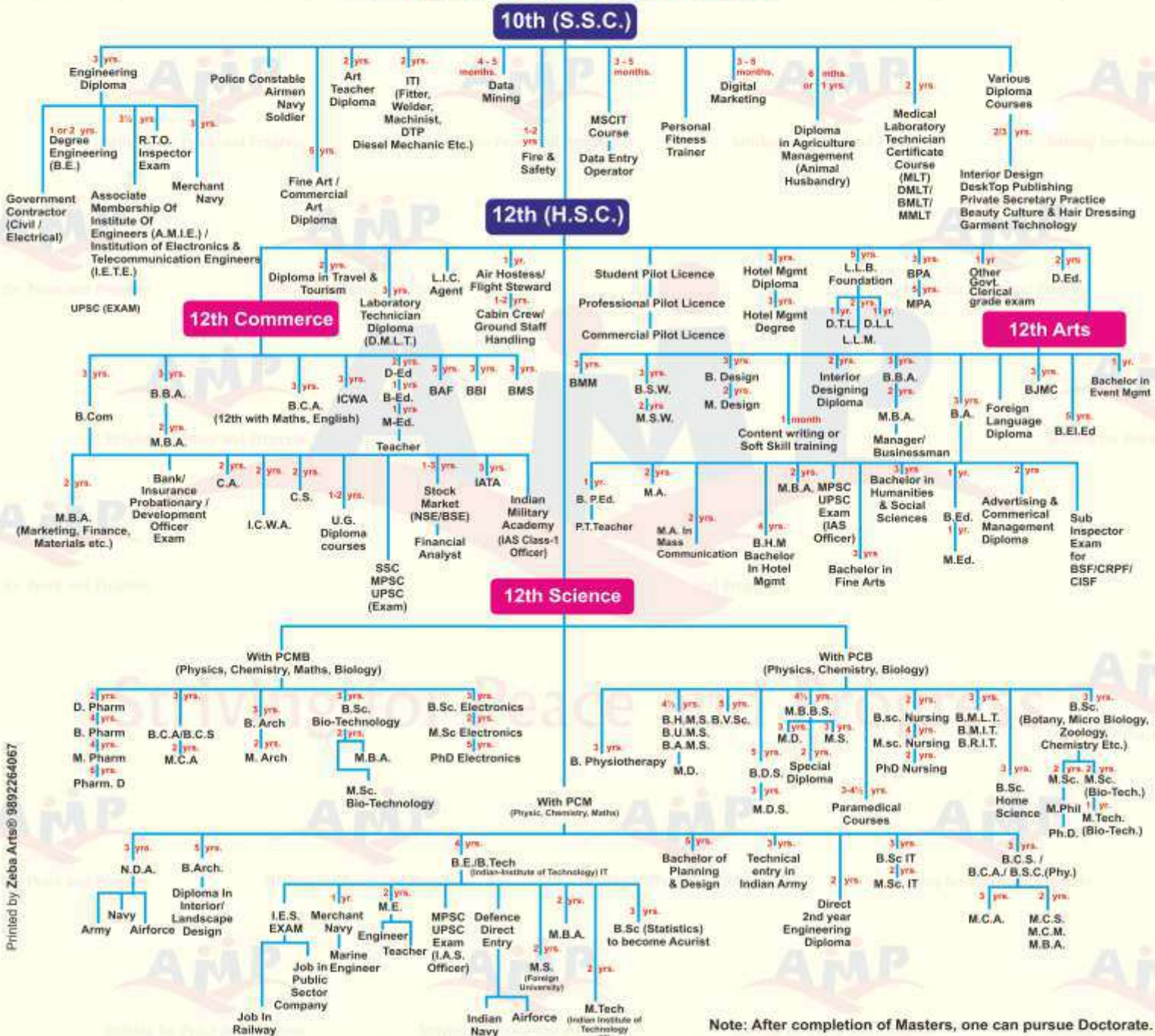
