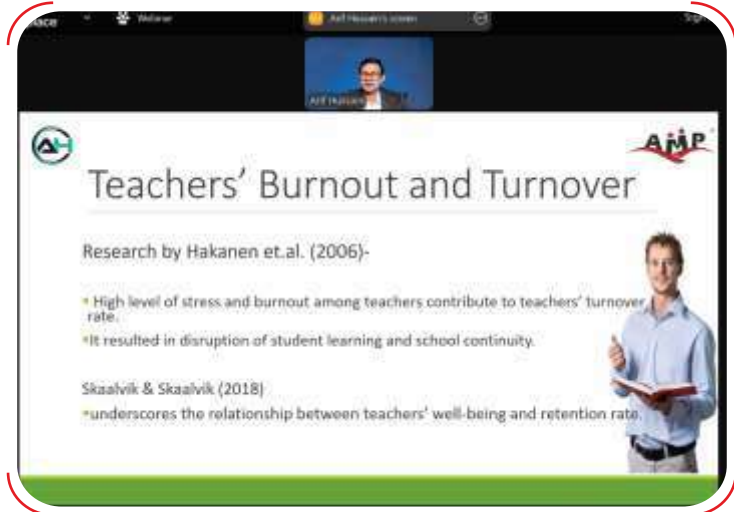
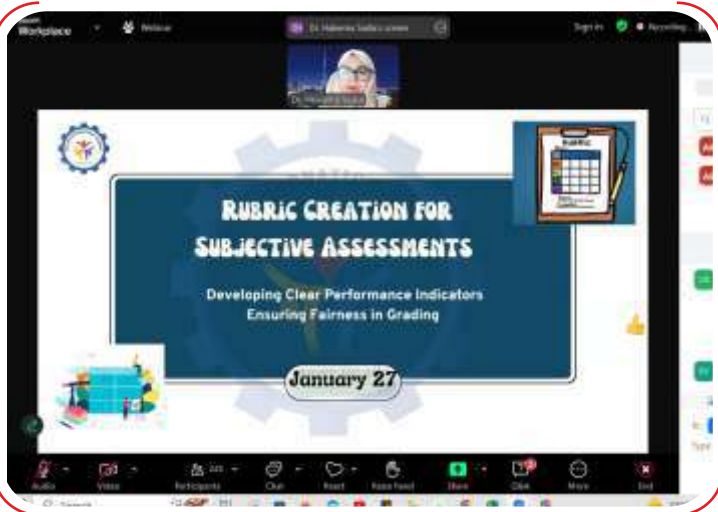

5 online TTP session were conducted, witnessing an overwhelming response with **2,077 participants**.



The Tata Ethical Fund is a Shariah-compliant investment fund that avoids sectors like gambling, alcohol, and conventional banking, focusing instead on ethical investments in financially stable companies such as Infosys, TCS, and Hindustan Unilever, aligning with Islamic principles and promoting socially responsible growth.

### No Gambling Companies

The fund does not invest in companies involved in gambling or any related activities, as it is considered haram (forbidden) in Islam.

### No liquor Companies

The fund excludes investments in companies that produce, distribute, or sell alcoholic beverages, which are also prohibited in Islamic law.



### No Conventional Banking

Investments in traditional banks and financial institutions that charge or pay interest (riba) are avoided, as interest is forbidden in Islam.

### Debt free Companies

The fund refrains from investing in companies with high levels of debt, as excessive debt and interest-bearing transactions conflict with Shariah principles.
