AMP Empowers Through Employment

**Over 1,200 Youth Selected & Shortlisted
Across 3 Mega Job Fairs in May 2025!**

In its ongoing mission to create meaningful job opportunities, AMP conducted a series of impactful Job Fairs across India in May 2025. These events, organized in collaboration with various partners and institutions, brought hope, access, and opportunities to thousands of aspiring youth, especially in underserved regions.

Across 4 major cities - Himmatnagar (GJ), Kilakarai (TN), Kanpur (UP), and Delhi - AMP facilitated events where over 2,600+ candidates were interviewed, resulting in the shortlisting and selection of more than 1,200 deserving youth.



Job Fair Highlights – May 2025

Himmatnagar, Gujarat (3rd May 2025)
